Age & Timing

BMI & Body Composition

THE FOUNDATION OF SURGICAL PLANNING

Body Mass Index is a starting point — not a verdict. We use BMI alongside body fat distribution, visceral fat assessment, and metabolic health markers to determine surgical readiness and optimize outcomes.

OPTIMAL RANGE FOR ELECTIVE SURGERY

Most cosmetic procedures yield the best and safest results when a patient's BMI falls below 30. This reflects lower anesthesia risk, reduced wound healing complications, improved aesthetic predictability, and more durable long-term results. For body contouring procedures specifically, a stable weight within 10–15 pounds of your goal is ideal.

ELEVATED BMI — HONEST CONVERSATIONS

If your BMI is above the optimal surgical range, we will have a candid, compassionate conversation. In some cases, medical weight management or staged procedures may be the safest and most effective path. We may recommend nutritional optimization, medically supervised weight loss, or pre-surgical conditioning to reduce risk and enhance your result.

WEIGHT STABILITY MATTERS

Significant weight fluctuation after surgery can compromise results. We look for a stable weight maintained for at least three to six months. For post-bariatric body contouring patients, we require weight stability for twelve months or longer. This protects your investment and ensures lasting results.

We partner with you before, during, and after surgery to ensure your body is in the best possible condition for the procedure — and the life — you want.

Skin Quality & Tissue Assessment

YOUR SKIN TELLS THE STORY — WE READ IT CAREFULLY

Skin quality is one of the most critical — and most overlooked — variables in surgical planning. Elasticity, thickness, texture, sun damage, and hydration all influence what is surgically achievable and how you will heal.

ELASTICITY & RECOIL

Skin that has strong elastic recoil will contract and drape beautifully over newly sculpted contours. We perform clinical elasticity assessments during consultation. Patients with diminished elasticity may benefit from combination approaches — surgical contouring paired with skin tightening technologies — to achieve the smoothest result.

THICKNESS & TEXTURE

Thin skin reveals underlying contour irregularities more readily; thick skin may obscure fine detail but holds shape well. Sun-damaged skin, smoker's skin, and skin with significant crepiness require modified techniques, gentler handling, and sometimes staged procedures. We tailor every plan to your unique tissue characteristics.

PRE-SURGICAL SKIN OPTIMIZATION

In many cases, we recommend a preparatory skin care regimen — medical-grade retinoids, antioxidants, and growth factors — for four to six weeks prior to surgery. This investment in your skin's cellular health translates directly to better healing, less scarring, and a more refined final result.

Volume & Shaping

THE ART OF DIMENSIONAL HARMONY

Modern plastic surgery is as much about adding and redistributing volume as it is about removing and tightening. The interplay between volume restoration, structural shaping, and soft tissue management defines the difference between a procedure and a transformation.

FACIAL VOLUME — THE YOUTH EQUATION

Youthful faces are defined by convexities — full cheeks, smooth lid-cheek junctions, and soft jawlines. Aging is fundamentally a process of deflation. Fat transfer, hyaluronic acid fillers, and structural fat grafting restore the volumetric architecture that time erodes. We analyze your facial proportions in three dimensions to determine where volume loss is driving the appearance of aging.

BODY SHAPING — BEYOND LIPOSUCTION

Body contouring is a sculptural discipline. We use high-definition liposuction, fat grafting, and tissue repositioning to create three-dimensional shape — not just reduce size. Medical Comorbidities & Safety

YOUR HEALTH IS THE NON-NEGOTIABLE PRIORITY

Cosmetic surgery is elective surgery — which means safety is not just important, it is the entire foundation. Every medical condition you carry into the operating room must be identified, optimized, and accounted for in our surgical plan.

CARDIOVASCULAR & METABOLIC HEALTH

Hypertension, diabetes, thyroid disorders, and cardiovascular disease must be well-controlled before elective surgery. We require recent lab work, medical clearance from your primary care physician or specialist, and in some cases, pre-operative cardiac evaluation. Uncontrolled conditions are not a permanent disqualification — they are a signal to optimize before we proceed.

SMOKING, MEDICATIONS & SUPPLEMENTS

Nicotine in any form — cigarettes, vaping, patches, gum — dramatically impairs wound healing and increases the risk of skin necrosis, infection, and poor scarring. We require complete nicotine cessation for a minimum of four to six weeks before and after surgery. Blood-thinning medications, herbal supplements, and certain vitamins must also be reviewed and adjusted under medical guidance.

MENTAL HEALTH & EMOTIONAL READINESS

We screen for body dysmorphic disorder, unrealistic expectations, and emotional readiness. Surgery performed during periods of acute stress, grief, or psychological instability rarely produces satisfaction. We approach this with compassion and directness — our goal is not to gatekeep, but to ensure the timing is right for your best outcome.

We will never compromise your safety for a timeline. When the time is right and your health is optimized, the results speak for themselves.

Face & Body Balance

PROPORTIONAL HARMONY OVER ISOLATED PERFECTION

A beautiful result in one area that is disconnected from the whole is not a beautiful result. We practice proportional aesthetics — evaluating the face as a complete system, the body as a unified form, and every procedure as part of a larger harmony.

FACIAL PROPORTIONAL ANALYSIS

We use established frameworks — the aesthetic ideal proportions, the Rule of Fifths, phi ratios — not as rigid formulas, but as diagnostic tools. The goal is to identify where asymmetries, disproportions, or age-related changes disrupt the visual flow of the face. A rhinoplasty must consider the chin. A facelift must consider the neck. Blepharoplasty must account for brow position. Nothing exists in isolation.

BODY PROPORTIONAL HARMONY

A breast augmentation must be proportional to your ribcage, your shoulders, your hip width, and your lifestyle. Abdominal contouring must transition naturally into the flanks and back. Gluteal shaping must respect the relationship between waist, hip, and thigh. We design each procedure within the context of your total silhouette — standing, sitting, and in motion.
